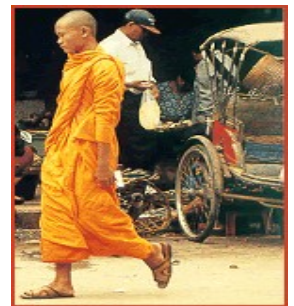
Sessions include:
